FOR ALL GRADES:

- November results of the previous year are used to determine Academic Award Winners.
- The November results constitute all School Based Assessment marks for all four terms and at the same weighting as used by Department of Education and as reflected on the final report of the learner, captured on SASAMS and as submitted to the Head of Department Education through
- the DATA DRIVEN DASHBOARD
- Marks to be looked at on the rating scale from 1 to 7 or percentages where a grading of 1 represents 0-29% and 7 represents a grading of 80-100%.
- An Academic Award winner will only be considered if all common SBA components have been completed timeously.

ACADEMIC BAR

Grade 6 - 8

Based on end of year results from the previous year

GRADE 6: 86% overall achievement GRADE 7: 84% overall achievement GRADE 8: 82% overall achievement *No subject average under 60%.

ACADEMIC TIE

Grade 9 & 10

Based on end of year results from the previous year

GRADE 9: overall average at end of year 80% and higher GRADE 10: overall average of 80% and higher

*No subject average under 60%.

Grade 11 & 12

Based on end of year results from the previous year

Grade 11: Awards based on the Grade 10 final November results

Half Colours

An overall average percentage of 75% or higher.

• Full Colours

An overall average of 80% or higher.

Grade 12: Awards base on the grade 11 final November results

An overall average of 75% or higher.

HONOURS AWARD

• 90 % overall average for two consecutive years (Grade 10 and 11), to be awarded in Term 1 of the Grade 12 year.
